

RULES AND REGULATIONS
14th ANNUAL ASHP CLINICAL SKILLS COMPETITION
FINAL ROUND: SUNDAY, DECEMBER 6, 2009

Congratulations on advancing to the final round of the competition!

- Please wear professional dress. Your team may wear your lab coats if you choose. There will be a photo session prior to your presentation.
- You have fifteen minutes to review the contents of your envelope which includes the forms and papers which were collected from the preliminary round.
- There will be no references to consult.
- Each team has a maximum of two minutes to present their case to a panel of judges, and a maximum of eight minutes for the question and answer period. **The two minute presentation should include: (1) identification of the student team members and their school/college name, (2) presentation of a brief patient summary with a list of all health problems that require immediate attention; and (3) presentation of recommendations for goals/treatment/monitoring of the most urgent problem only.** An example is listed on page 6 of the Coordinator's Handbook on the ASHP Web site at: http://www.ashp.org/DocLibrary/AboutUs/Awards/2009_CSC_Handbook.pdf
- Either or both team members may present the case, and answer questions. Assume the audience is the clinical team rounding with you and you are in charge of the patient.
- If you take questions during the presentation period, you have forfeited the remaining presentation time.
- There will be no questions taken from the audience. Questions are from the judges only.
- Once you have given your presentation, you are welcome to sit in the audience and hear other presentations.
- No finalists will be allowed into the room until they have presented.
- **The judges, case writers and competition coordinators will hold a debriefing session for all interested CSC participants.** This will include a review of the answer key and Q&A at the conclusion of the finalist presentations at 4:30 p.m. on Sunday, December 6th, in **Room 2102, Bellini, Level 2, Venetian Conference Center.** This session is designed to help you understand what the judges were looking for in the written and oral presentation portions of the competition.
- **Please plan to attend the Student Reception, from 4:30-6:00 p.m. on Sunday, December 6th, at the Palazzo Ballroom E, Level 5, Venetian Conference Center where the winners of the competition will be announced. All top 10 finalist teams will be called to the stage. Please arrive at the reception no later than 5:15 p.m. and gather in close proximity to the stage.**
