### **Congratulations to Barry R. Goldspiel, Pharm.D., BCOP, BCPS, 2011 ASHP Francke Medalist**

The 2011 ASHP Francke Medalist is Dr. Barry Goldspiel. Established in 1971, the ASHP Donald E. Francke Medal honors pharmacists who have made significant international contributions to health-system pharmacy. The medal is conferred at the discretion of the ASHP Board of Directors.

Dr. Barry Goldspiel is Deputy Chief, Chief of the Clinical Pharmacy Specialist Section, and Program Director of the PGY-2 Residency in Oncology Pharmacy at the National Institutes of Health Clinical Center Pharmacy Department in Bethesda, Maryland. He received his B.S. in Pharmacy from the Arnold and Marie Schwartz College of Pharmacy in Brooklyn, New York and a Doctor of Pharmacy degree from the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, Texas. He completed a Specialized Residency in Oncology Pharmacy Practice at the Audie L. Murphy Veterans Hospital in San Antonio. He is certified by the Board of Pharmacy Specialties (BPS) as a Board-Certified Pharmacotherapy Specialist (BCPS) and a Board-Certified Oncology Pharmacist (BCOP)

Dr. Goldspiel is an active member of several pharmacy societies including the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists (ASHP), American College of Clinical Pharmacy (ACCP), the International Society of Oncology Pharmacy Practitioners (ISOPP), and the Hematology/Oncology Pharmacy Association (HOPA). He is a fellow of ASHP, ACCP, and ISOPP and an honorary member and past-president of ISOPP and HOPA. He was a co-author on the successful petition to have Oncology Pharmacy recognized as a pharmacy specialty. Dr. Goldspiel is the founding Editor of the *Journal of Oncology Pharmacy Practice*, the official publication of the (ISOPP).

Dr. Goldspiel resides in Germantown, Maryland with his wife, Nancy, who is also a pharmacist, and his three children, Sherry, Ethan, and Justin.
