ASHP Student Leadership Award Program

DESCRIPTION

The ASHP Student Leadership Award recognizes students with an interest in pharmacy practice in health-systems who have demonstrated leadership ability. This program recognizes and celebrates the contributions of students who represent the very best attributes and accomplishments of ASHP student members. ASHP offers up to twelve awards annually. Pharmacy students in the second through fourth professional years are eligible to apply. The award consists of a plaque, an ASHP drug information reference library, and a \$2,500 cash award provided by the ASHP Research and Education Foundation.

OBJECTIVES

The primary objective of the ASHP Student Leadership Award is to foster continued personal and professional development through a formal recognition program. A secondary objective is to recognize student leader role models who have an interest in health-system practice and encourage student involvement in professional organizations.

FUNDING

The award program is administered by the ASHP Pharmacy Student Forum. The award plaque and ASHP drug information library is provided by ASHP. The cash award is provided by the Walter Jones Memorial Pharmacy Student Financial Aid Fund of the ASHP Research and Education Foundation.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must be a full-time pharmacy student enrolled in a professional Doctor of Pharmacy program at an ACPE-accredited college of pharmacy.
2. Applicants must be an ASHP member in good standing.
3. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of a least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent grading system).
4. Applicants must have completed at least one academic year in their professional pharmacy program.
5. Students who have received an ASHP Student Leadership Award in the past or who are currently serving on an ASHP Council, the Commission on Affiliate Relations or the Pharmacy Student Forum Executive Committee are not eligible to apply.

CRITERIA

Criteria for the award will be used in the recipient selection process. Applicants will be evaluated based on the following evenly weighed criteria:

1. *Health-System Pharmacy Practice Achievement:* Evidence of interest, achievement and leadership in health-system pharmacy practice as demonstrated by work experience, professional achievement in hospital/health-system rotations, completion of a research project and/or other special projects or professional accomplishments.
2. *Professional Organization Leadership:* Evidence of involvement, demonstrated accomplishments, and leadership positions held in student professional organizations, the ASHP state affiliate, student society of health-system pharmacy, and/or community service.
3. *Personal Leadership Attributes:* Demonstrated by testimonials from student peers and professionals in letters of recommendation and essay response. Attributes that should be emphasized include motivation and enablement of others to get involved, successful leadership in a team atmosphere, excellence in leading by example, the use of creativity and enthusiasm, the ability to establish and work toward shared goals and the display of leadership through action.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS & PROCEDURE

To be accepted, the completed application **must be mailed to arrive at the ASHP office no later than 5:00pm Eastern Time on January 30, 2012.** An e-mail confirmation of receipt will be sent to the applicant when the completed application is received. Please print application materials single-sided and do not staple.

- Completed application form (page 1)
- Completed Professional Activities Form (see page 2)
- A resume or curriculum vitae (clearly differentiate between experiential rotations, work experience, and/or volunteer experience).
- An essay of no more than 750 words conveying your thoughts on the evolving Pharmacy Practice Model. Describe your view on how hospital and health-system pharmacists should engage in the development of a future practice model taking into consideration the evolution of pharmacy practice over the last 50 years including:
 - medication-use policy and product selection;
 - medication distribution;
 - clinical pharmacy practice;
 - pharmacy technician roles;
 - pharmacists' roles as organizational leaders;
 - adherence to standards-based practice;
 - response to the medication-use safety quality and safety movements in the U.S.; and
 - impact of technology.
 Describe your perceived leadership role (as a practicing pharmacist) in helping to implement this practice model.
- Three (3) completed recommendation forms (see page 3). One recommendation should come from a faculty member, the second a pharmacist practitioner, and third from a student peer. All letters of recommendation should address the applicant's ability to meet the award criteria. *Please note: Each of the three letters should be received by the applicant in a sealed envelope (signature of recommender over sealed flap) and sent on to ASHP with the completed application materials.*
