Results

Our membership drive increased our membership numbers by at least 1/3 of the incoming P1 class as they indicated an interest in joining the organization.

What tools were most effective for recruiting SSHP members?

The Meet and Greet Membership Drive was intended to recruit incoming P1 students during their College of Pharmacy Orientation. We held the event during the morning break time between orientation activities. The active involvement of student leaders and officers during this event was the most effective strategy at recruiting new members. We also heavily utilized our HU-SSHP Facebook Page to present information about our student society to the new students.



How did you use ASHP resources to assist in the membership drive?

We utilized the pamphlets and promotional materials provided by ASHP to advertise our student society. We also used a portion of the funds we received from the SSHP Development Grant from the previous year to purchase snacks and refreshments for interested members.

What will you change for your next membership drive?

For this event, we provided sodas, cookies, and a small selection of fruits. However, students seemed to prefer healthier choices such as bananas and water. Also, for the next membership drive, we will try to include the participation of active student members as well.

Future Plans and Goals
