The ASHP Research and Education Foundation is offering \$220,000 in research funding between June 1, 2011 and May 31, 2012 to support advancement of pharmacy practice models in hospitals and health systems.

Pharmacy Resident Practice-Based Research Grant

The Pharmacy Resident Practice-Based Research Grant supports studies, related to the ASHP/ASHP Foundation Pharmacy Practice Model Initiative (PPMI), conducted by residents in ASHP-accredited pharmacy residency programs or by residents in pharmacy residency programs that have submitted an application for ASHP accreditation. Up to six \$5,000 grants will be awarded.

New Investigator Research Grant

The New Investigator Research Grant Program supports practice-based research, related to the ASHP/ASHP Foundation Pharmacy Practice Model Initiative (PPMI), conducted by pharmacist new investigators. A secondary goal of the program is to develop new investigators' research skills while fostering development of mentoring relationships with more experienced senior investigators. Up to two \$20,000 grants will be awarded.

Pharmacy Practice Model Initiative Demonstration Grants

Up to six \$25,000 grants will be offered through the PPMI Demonstration Grant Program. The proposed research must involve demonstration projects focused on the PPMI research priorities that are provided in the [application instructions](#). The principal investigator must be a licensed pharmacist and multidisciplinary research teams are strongly encouraged. The principal investigator must have a strong research track record as evidenced by a history of publication of original research in peer-reviewed biomedical journals and receipt of extramural grant funding.
