

Pharmacy Student Education at an Integrated Health System

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The pharmacy department at Cambridge Health Alliance (with numerous sites in Cambridge and Boston, Massachusetts) offers a model twelve-week inpatient rotation in which pharmacy interns are exposed to various types of hospital settings. The students work closely with the medical teams during daily rounds; and are responsible for a variety of projects including Journal Club, Medical Grand Rounds, drug utilization reviews, presenting at nursing education programs, medication reconciliation, participating in Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee, and Institutional Review Board.
