Ms. Pawlicki received her Bachelor of Science degree in Pharmacy from Ferris State University in Big Rapids, Michigan and her Master of Science degree in Pharmacy Administration from Wayne State University in Detroit, Michigan, and she completed an American Society of Health-System Pharmacy (ASHP) accredited residency in hospital pharmacy. Ms. Pawlicki was recognized as a Fellow of ASHP in 2001.
