William (Bill) Smith and wife, Kay visited ASHP on Friday, January 8, 2010 to donate items from the collection of late Donald Brodie. In attendance were the Smiths, William (Bill) Zellmer, Richard Talley, and Anne Callas.

Start of the meeting, Bill Smith explained how he acquired the items. He met Brodie (a Professor) as a student at the University of California. They worked together and developed a lasting professional and personal friendship. Much of this relationship was documented in Bill Smith's Oral History (interviewed by Bill Zellmer).

When Don Brodie passed away in 1994, the Smiths remained friends with his wife, Frances Brodie. When Frances passed away in 2009, she left the Smith's the documents which they are donating today.
