

Herbert Flack Donation/Slide Collection

Information Provided by Charles King via email conversation to William Zellmer (dated May 17th, 2010):

"When Herb died, we met his daughter, Helen at the memorial service. I knew Herb had a lot of hospital pharmacy memorabilia, artifacts, etc. and I hoped that they would not be thrown away. Ann and I offered to return, at a later date, to Herb's house and help Helen to go through, things pharmaceutical, and offered to take them to the ASHP Archives. When we returned, Helen had gone through most of the personal things and saved a few things for us to look at that she was not sure of. We went through the files she had given us first and pulled out whatever there was. As I recall, it was not a whole lot, but the slides were a different story. Herb must have taken a camera on every trip he took. I know he was always "documenting" his visits when he came to see us.

[Back to the business at hand.] Before we started, I assured Helen that she should take anything she wanted because all these things were in fact hers, and that I would appreciate taking to the ASHP anything of pharmaceutical interest that she didn't want. That was fine with her. I just sat down at a table and started going through the slides, giving Helen any that looked like they were of family or not about pharmacy. There were some pictures that included Herb and I checked with her and she decided each on an individual basis. After reviewing, we stored all the pharmacy slides in boxes. They all seemed to be coded somehow and about half way through the process, I think I figured it out. I'm not too sure exactly how it was but something like: state, city, hospital and the date was in there somewhere. When we finished, we just loaded everything into the car and headed for the ASHP. I don't remember if Waneta was there when we delivered everything. I do remember I talked with her a few time after we returned home."
