Introductory Leadership Program

The **Leadership Speakers Bureau** has a roster of pharmacy leaders around the country who will visit your Student Society of Health-System Pharmacists and speak about leadership topics. Awards

The **ASHP Student Leadership Awards** recognize students with an interest in health-system pharmacy practice who have demonstrated leadership ability. ASHP offers 12 awards annually, four to student members in each professional year of pharmacy school, beginning with the second professional year. Each award recipient receives a plaque, an ASHP drug information reference library, and a \$2,000 cash award provided by the ASHP Foundation. The **Student Research Literature Award** is given to a pharmacy student for a published paper that describes a completed research project related to medication use completed during the student's first through fourth professional years in a college/school of pharmacy. The recipient



receives a \$1,500 honorarium, a \$1,000 expense allowance to attend the ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting for the award ceremony, recognition at the annual Literature Awards Breakfast, and a plaque. For more information, visit www.ashpfoundation.org/litawards.
