Arriving in Denver: Meeting and Delegate Registration

Before arriving in Denver, all delegates must register to attend one of the four [Summer Meetings](#). Upon arrival in Denver, you must also register onsite as a delegate (or alternate delegate) to receive your official credentials. Delegates and alternates can get their House of Delegates credentials at the Hyatt Regency on Saturday, June 2 from 7:00 to 10:30 a.m., and at the Denver Convention Center Lobby F from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday and from 7 to 11 a.m. on Sunday. Delegates who miss those hours must register in the Executive Office (Room 608) after 11:30 a.m. on Sunday.

Once registered, you may use your credentials to attend all the events organized for ASHP delegates outlined in the [Meetings at a Glance](#). The [Checklist for Delegates](#) is also a helpful reminder to prepare for all the important events in Denver. If your state delegation must replace a delegate with an alternate delegate after the Sunday Meeting of the House, the alternate should present at the ASHP Executive Office (Room 608) before 3:00 p.m., or to Dr. Hannah Vanderpool in the House meeting room between 3:00 and 4:00 p.m., on Tuesday. If a state wishes to credential a new delegate or alternate delegate other than one previously

registered with ASHP, the following procedure must be followed: state delegates and alternates must be active ASHP members, and delegates and alternate delegates are considered certified only if the communication is sent to ASHP (wparris@ashp.org) from a president or executive of an ASHP-affiliated state society. Credentials must be received before 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday.

Numerous Potential Amendments

Proposed amendments must be prepared for large-screen projection in the House. It is essential that all proposed language is received well in advance for viewing by the entire House of Delegates. Computers in the Delegate Workroom (Room 606) are pre-loaded with the [Amending Language Form](#) (as well as forms for [Recommendations](#) and [New Business Items](#)). Proposed amendments should be submitted as described in the form and may be given to staff members in the Delegate Workroom before **noon on Sunday**.
