3-year plan offers 180 hours (minimum) as follows:

Ambulatory Care Self-Assessment Program—90 hours

Literature Study Module — 24 hours

Clinical Sessions — 18 hours

#### ▶ CRITICAL CARE PHARMACY

100 hours of recertification credit required

3-year plan offers 113 hours (minimum) as follows:

Online Recert Course — 32 hours (2 courses @ 16 each)

Literature Study Modules — 60 hours

Core Therapeutic Modules — 9 hours

Intensive Studies — 12 hours

#### **▶ GERIATRIC PHARMACY\***

100 hours of recertification credit required
